Drug Misuse

Drug Misuse – enhanced service commenced (must be recorded to be included in your enhanced service claims)	Lower payment – 80% will be achieved by recording the following:	
	Drug misuse consultation	Twice during the 6 months prior to the end of the audit period
	SMR	At any time prior to the end of the audit period
	Toxicology	At least once during the 12 months prior to the end of audit period
	Full payment – will be achieved by the addition of:	
Hep B immunisations (record of either Hep B immunisation stage, or Hep B immunisation declined, or Previous Hep B infection)	At any time prior to the end of the audit period
